For Jack Russell Racing, Earth Dog / Go To Ground and Lure Coursing, Drafting and Dancing Directions:

Route 66 to Humphreys Street.
 Turn north on Humphreys. North is toward the mountain.
 Turn west / left on Birch.

Turn north / right on Aztec, go through Cherry St.
Aztec road dead-ends.
On left there is a parking lot.
